As the Kurilpa Bridge is owned by the Department of Housing and Public Works, Minister Bailey's office has forwarded your enquiry to the Honourable Mick de Brenni MP, Minister for Housing and Public Works, Minister for Digital Technology and Minister for Sport. I am replying on the Minister's behalf.

I note that Brisbane City Council representatives have recently discussed a possible future pedestrian and cycle bridge linking Alice/Edward Streets, Brisbane City to Kangaroo Point with the Brisbane Central Business District Bicycle User Group.
