My dear Lord Mayor

I write concerning the metal boxes near the Go-Between Bridge.

I noted in February 2017<sup>1</sup>

*These kiosks were opened September 2013 and the last lease ended June 2015.*

Thus, they have now been unused for more than three and half years. This whole exercise has been a very poor use of public funds.

On 1 March 2018 you wrote to the BUG

*I appreciate you taking the time to request a further update on the future use of the kiosks near the Go Between Bridge and Bicentennial Bikeway. Council is currently preparing the paperwork for a formal Expression of Interest (EOI) process to be conducted before 30 June.*

*As mentioned in my letter of 6 June 2017, Council's intent is to identify a suitable operator of the kiosks under a community licence model. At this stage, there are no plans to relocate the kiosks, however, further consideration will be given should a suitable organisation not be identified through the EOI process.*

Could you please provide a further update on how the EOI process went and the future use of these kiosks?

I look forward to your response on this issue.
